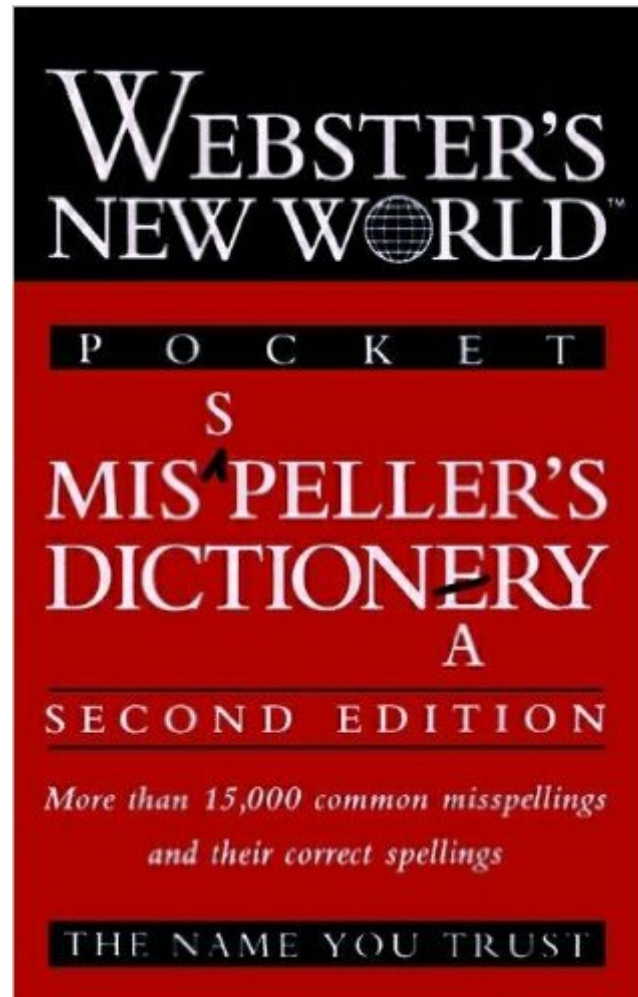

I ordered this book to help my students who simply can't spell. I'm amazed at how many students use this handy book to help them write essays and to correct their errors. My students find it quick

The possibilities and opportunities to spell English words wrong approach the infinite! It's not bad for an "on the go" reference, but will not suffice as an office reference. This book has, perhaps nine or ten thousand possible misspellings in a language where there are (Dare I say?) millions of misspelling pitfalls.

I'm still in a little quandary about this item. I have given this as a gift to others with whom I've worked that had spelling problems and it's been a godsend for them. In this instance I am considering giving it to my great nephew who has difficulty spelling, including difficulty finding the words in the dictionary because he doesn't know how to spell them correctly. On the one hand, it would help him to find the words in the dictionary for definitions, parts of speech, etc. Question is, would he use it like that or just to get the right spelling down and feel as though he never has to learn how to spell. So far, I'm the one that uses it...and don't laugh at me! This is a great little book of commonly misspelled words, so I use it to building spelling lessons for the two children I homeschool. It is absolutely PERFECT for this application. Would I recommend this book to others? I have and I will continue to do so. It is a tremendous aid for adults who have not learned to spell well.
